

Degreed-iMocha Integration – Initial Setup Document

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1. Overview

The iMocha–Degreed integration enables organizations to seamlessly sync assessments, completions, and skill scores between iMocha and Degreed. This collaboration empowers learning and development teams to track employee upskilling efforts directly within the Degreed platform.

2. Objective

The objective of this document is to outline the step-by-step process required to set up the integration between iMocha and Degreed. This includes prerequisites, configuration steps, and key features enabled through the integration.

4. Integration Highlights

- Official Partnership: iMocha is a certified Degreed content provider.
- Real-Time Sync: New and updated assessments in iMocha are automatically reflected in Degreed.
- Skill Scores & Completions: Completion records, including skill ratings, are updated in near real-time.
- SSO & Deep Linking: A frictionless user experience through single sign-on and direct assessment links.

5. Content Synchronization

Once the integration is activated, all assessments from the organization's iMocha account are made available in Degreed. The integration supports:

- Adding New Assessments
- Updating Existing Assessments
- Real-Time Publishing & Availability

6. Completion & Skill Score Sync

Each time a learner completes an iMocha assessment, a completion record is sent to Degreed within seconds or minutes. This record includes:

- Learner completion status
- Assessment metadata
- Skill scores (if available)

This helps organizations maintain an up-to-date view of skill development within Degreed's reporting and Skill Signals features.

7. SSO & Deep Linking

Every assessment shared with Degreed includes a launch URL (deep link). If Single Sign-On (SSO) is enabled:

- Learners are first authenticated via their identity provider.
- They are then redirected to the assessment on iMocha.
- If already signed in via a shared identity provider (e.g., through their LMS), no additional login is required.

This ensures a smooth and secure navigation experience between platforms.

8. Pre-requisites

Before initiating the integration, please ensure:

- An active Degreed organization account
- An active subscription with iMocha
- Administrator privileges in Degreed

9. Integration Setup Steps

Step 1: Create iMocha as a Provider in Degreed

- Log into Degreed Admin.
- Navigate to the Provider Management section.
- Add a new provider and name it iMocha.

Step 2: Generate Degreed API Credentials

- Create API credentials for the iMocha provider.
- Assign the following scopes:
 - o content:write
 - o providers:read
 - o completions:write
 - o users:read
 - skill_rating:write
- Securely store the generated Client ID and Client Secret.

Step 3: Share Credentials with iMocha

Send the following details to your iMocha integration contact:

- Client ID
- Client Secret
- Degreed API Base URL / Data Center URL

The iMocha team will use these credentials to configure the integration and initiate the first content sync.
